Use the questions below to help extend the impact of the weekend message. They are not only useful in your LifeGroup, but try discussing with your family, friends, and co-workers for even greater understanding and spiritual growth.

Week of April 6th-12th

Opening Prayer: Begin with a brief prayer asking God to open your hearts to His Word and for His guidance in your discussion.

Icebreaker: Can you think of a time when someone served you in an unexpected or humble way? How did it make you feel?

Base Passages: John 13:1-20, John 14:15-31

Discussion Questions

- Understanding the Context: Alan's sermon described the scene of Jesus washing the disciples' feet during the Passover meal. Why do you think Jesus chose this moment to teach about humility and service? How do you think the disciples felt when Jesus, their Teacher and Lord, began washing their feet?
- **Humble Service:** Does Jesus' command to "wash one another's feet" (John 13:14) apply to us today? If so, what does "washing one another's feet" look like in our lives today? How does Jesus' upside-down model of what a leader is challenge your thinking of church leadership?
- Challenging Seasons: Alan connected the feelings of confusion and doubt that Jesus' disciples must have felt to our current season here at Cumberland. What are some responses we might have (in the flesh and in the Spirit) to feeling like "the rug is pulled out from under you"?
- **Empowered To Serve:** Knowing YOU have been empowered to serve others in the name of Jesus, what are some practical ways you could serve others more? Is there something that has been holding you back from doing so? How might this group help you in overcoming those things?
- The Role of the Holy Spirit: Jesus promised the Holy Spirit as a helper and guide (John 14:15-31). How have you experienced the Holy Spirit's guidance in your life? Alan pointed out that we can't continue to claim ignorance or fear and still claim the Holy Spirit indwells us. Do you agree? Why or why not?

Group Challenge:

- This week, identify one person in your life who needs encouragement or help in some way. Serve them in a simple, humble way (e.g., a kind note, a meal, a helping hand). Share your experience with the group at the next gathering.
- Take a few minutes to reflect upon John 13:15-17. Read it aloud and then spend a moment in silence reflecting on how God may be calling you to serve others right now.

Closing Prayer

Share any personal needs for prayer. Pray for opportunities to serve others individually, as group, and as the Church. Pray for the courage necessary to live out Jesus' example of a humble servant leader.
