In His Presence

"He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty." (Psalm 91:1).

There is a simple truth in life that says you cannot give out what you do not possess. If you expect to be able to operate from a position of spiritual strength, first you must do the things that help you possess spiritual strength. At the top of that list comes living in the shelter of the Most High.

What the psalmist is describing speaks of a consistent presence. It is the exact same concept that Jesus portrays in John 15 when He describes Himself as the vine and His faithful followers as branches that remain in Him. The result He said was the branch bearing "much fruit."

It's popular to hear in Christianity about a "personal relationship with the Lord." However, I think we miss the glory of what God wants with us if we settle for nothing more than a "personal relationship." What His Word describes He wants with us is "fellowship."

God invites us to gather to rest and recharge by consistently abiding in His love and mercy. While that sounds like an offer no believer could refuse, it often is. Many times believers so overwhelm their lives with the busyness of this world that there is little room for left for dwelling in the shelter of the Most High.
