From the Preacher's Desk

The Potter Works the Clay

"No, don't say that. Who are you, a mere human being, to argue with God? Should the thing that was created say to the one who created it, "Why have you made me like this?" (Romans 9:20 NLT).

Job demanded that God explain Himself. God did speak to Job, but when He did, He made it clear that Job what not His equal.

In Deuteronomy 23:3-4 God declares that "no Ammonite or Moabite or any of their descendants for ten generations may be admitted to the assembly of the Lord." Yet Ruth, a Moabite, is not only the grandmother of King David, but one of only five women mentioned in Matthew in the lineage of Jesus. Who are we to question, "but God, she's a Moabite?"

Maybe the great prophet Isaiah puts it in a way we can best understand it. "My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts, says the Lord. And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine."

Often we find it way too easy to fill in the "white spaces" between the verses in scripture. God never intended for us to understand all of His ways. What He commanded foremost to us is to "love Him as our God with all our heart, all our soul, and all our mind." Further He commanded us second most to "love our neighbor as ourselves."

Being His faithful servant means being able to accept our limitations and His unfailing ways.
